## 2012 INTRODUCTIONS

**CHARIOT OF CLOUDS TET 38104** [(Storm Shelter x [(sdlg x Tet. Lavender Blue Baby) x Lake Effect]) x (Secret of Contentment x Heartbeat of Heaven)], 34" (range of 32-36"), M, Sev (with lots of dormancy), fr, EMO, Re (incl. some MN instant Re some years), 7", 3-way branching (1+V or W), 17 buds (with range of 10-20). Dark hot cranberry rose with darker rose eye, pink lavender watermark, pink lavender edge trimmed in ivory, yellow to green throat. I have taken almost 100 pictures of this one and every bloom is different, ranging from super-ruffled and absolutely stunning to less ruffled to gnarly; from flawless to spotted; from triangular to round. See website for examples. Because of this inconsistency, I would say it is more of a hybridizer's plant – at least in zone 4. Amazing in greenhouse and lots more buds. Very powerful parent and highly recommended as a way to get large, ruffled, hardy flowers with great color (mostly cranberries, hot pinks, and purples - see website). Thanks to this flower I now have a wonderful pink program. Fertile both ways.....\$150

**CROWN OF SPLENDOR TET 69204** [(Way of Life x Lake Effect) x (sdlg x Tet LBB)] x [Heartbeat of Heaven x (sdlg x Tet LBB)], 28" (range of 28"-32"), M (to late mid), Dor, fr, Re (and instant MN rebloom on virtually all fans), 6-8" with average bloom size of 6.5" and 3.75" petals, 3-way branching with 22 buds (13+ on rebloom scapes). Pale pink lavender, faint lavender halo, large pale yellow edge, yellow to green throat. Color changes depending on temperature. Darker lavender when cool. On warmer days, from a distance it looks pale, pale pink or pale yellow because of the large yellow edge and throat (that some days can be extra large). Long bloom season (into September here). In our zone it takes a while for it to show its blooms at their best; an established plant that has been in the ground for 2 years will be really lovely and stop people in their tracks. Makes large fans (but not usually in a greenhouse setting, due to its strong dormancy). Pod fertile; pollen doesn't look good. My breeding is focused on darker colors so I didn't make many seeds with this – but see website for a lovely offspring.....\$100

**DEFINING MOMENT TET 26305** [(Tomorrow's Glory x Absolute Treasure) x Born to Reign] x (No More Tears x Tet Painted Rose) x [(Eyes on the Prize x Belle Cooke) x Born to Reign], 36", M, Dor, fr, 6.5", 4-way branching (ranging from 3-7) with 18 buds (range of 10-24; registered at 15 buds in crowded year with drought). Blood red with soft cranberry pink watermark, gold filigree, green throat, no overlapping segments. It has many looks – usually showing movement and pinching, with pleating in the throat most pronounced on cooler days. Some days it is more round. Very rapid grower (leave a lot of room) with lots of scapes. Well-spaced laterals that display the flowers well. Very hardy and vigorous, but does not like to be divided in the heat of the summer and may go dormant (if it happens, and looks like it has died, don't worry – it will come back the next year just fine). Introduced as a gift plant for the 2011 Region 1 summer meeting and tour, so limited quantity.....\$50

**EL SHADDAI TET 75404** {Enduring Freedom x [(Heartbeat of Heaven x (Regal Majesty x Clothed in Glory))], 30", M, Sev (Ev in GH, Sev outside), EMO, fr, Re (instant rebloom in MN on almost all fans), 7", 4-way with 2 laterals plus V (range of 3-7 way), 31 buds (range of 20-42). Deep lavender pink, lavender wash, lavender plus ivory plus pale yellow edge, yellow to green triangular throat. Beautiful clump with large, lovely blooms with thick substance. Very strong, hardy plant. Opens well on cold nights. Fertile both ways.....\$125

**INSCRIBED ON MY HEART TET 10205** [(sdlg x Wolf Eyes) x Mardi Gras Ball] x Julie Newmar) x [Intelligent Design x [(sdlg x Druid's Chant) x Desperado Love]] x Julie Newmar], 26" (range of 22-31" among different clumps and years), M, Sev, fr, Re (and some instant Re in MN), 7", 4-way (range of 3-5), 16 buds (range of 10-30). Clear ivory with pink blush, purple feathery eye and edge, green throat. Dramatic flower with great color contrast. Much admired and photographed by visitors. Hardy and a good increaser in unprotected locations here in zone 4, but not consistently robust on every clump and on every scape in every year. My guess is that this flower's sweet spot is in zone 5 and up. Fertile both ways and a terrific parent. See pictures of offspring on the website.....\$125

**LIVING WATER TET 69004** [Unknown x (Filled to Overflowing x Heartbeat of Heaven)], 28", LM, Sev (with lots of Dor), fr, 4.5", 4-way branching (ranging from 2-3 when crowded and 3-6 when not) with 30 buds (range of 15-35). Deep pink lavender, pale gray lavender watermark, gray lavender plus ivory gold edge, olive throat. Clumps quickly; a very nice plant with lots of bloom. My guess is that it is fertile both ways but haven't tested it.....\$75

**SKIN OF MY TEETH TET 29504** [(Chance Encounter x Shaka Zulu) x (Fortune's Dearest x Lifting Me Higher) x Doyle Pierce] x (Heartbeat of Heaven x sdlg)], 26", M, Sev, fr, Re (incl. some MN instant rebloom), 3-way (W), 15 buds (range of 14-22). Rich, clear, dark purple with etched faint dark lavender eye and edge plus ivory or ivory gold sharks teeth, yellow to green throat. Very hardy; rapid increaser; great in the rain. Usually blooms into September. Stunning when at its best. Heavy dew will cause it to spot periodically (see website), so this one got introduced by the "skin of its teeth" based on its good days and because it is an outstanding parent for beautiful clear colors with sharks teeth (see website). Fertile both ways.....\$150

**SOLI DEO GLORIA TET 22305** [(Fortune's Dearest x Shaka Zulu) x Rock of Salvation] x JT Davis] x Heartbeat of Heaven) x [Heartbeat of Heaven x (Lifting Me Higher x Fortune's Dearest) x (Forbidden Desires x Tet LBB))] x [(Gnashing of Teeth x (Night Town x Larry Grace)) x Rock of Salvation], 26", LM, Sev, easy opener, vfr, Re, 6-1/2", 3-way (range of 2-4-way) with 20 buds. Stunning, clear velvety saturated dark purple with lighter lavender purple watermark, yellow to green throat, trimmed in

white ivory which will show lots of sharks when temps are in the 80's and up (pictured here on a cool day – see website for warm days). Thick substance; recurved. Might show spots on the first couple of blooms due to thrip, but the rest of the summer it is almost flawless on hundreds of bloom despite heavy dew. A favorite of Spring Fling participants no matter what their breeding interests for its wonderful consistency and beautiful color and form. Much admired by 2007 convention visitors and planned to be included in the upcoming Landscaping with Daylilies book. Good reports from West Virginia and North Carolina (where it was planted and grown in consistent 90-105 degree heat and drought and it bloomed with good color and remained strong). Very fertile both ways. Haven't yet seen many kids on this one, but will be loads in the spring (will put them on the blog as they bloom).....\$200

**STRANGER IN A STRANGE LAND TET 75704** {[Filled to Overflowing x (sdlg x Tet Lavender Blue Baby)] x Heartbeat of Heaven} x {[Pirate Lady x Tet Lavender Blue Baby] x (Uppermost Edge x sdlg)] x [(Regal Majesty x Clothed in Glory) x Heartbeat of Heaven]], 24", LM (and blooms well into September most years), Dor (outside most years and in the greenhouse; was Sev one year outside on one clump and Dor elsewhere), fr, Re (instant rebloom in Minnesota on all fans with at least 10 buds on each), 5", 3-way, 15 buds (range of 12-22). Violet grape, blue lavender eye and edge trimmed in ivory, yellow to green throat. Very unusual color when cool or overcast, hence the name. Washed out and boring in the afternoon if high heat and solid sun. Very hardy, tough plant that does well in shade and drought. Good grower and increaser that blooms for at least a month. Fertile both ways.....\$75

**THISTLES AND THORNS TET 67404** {[Lifting Me Higher x Fortune`s Dearest] x (Forbidden Desires x Tet Lavender Blue Baby)] x (Filled to Overflowing x Heartbeat of Heaven)}, 30" (range of 24"-32", depending on type of soil where it is planted), M, Sev, fr, Re (MN instant rebloom on most fans) 6", 5-way (3 laterals plus a V, with range of 4-6 way), 30 buds (with range of 20-40). Violet purple with lavender watermark and edge plus white sharks teeth and a yellow to green throat. An AMAZINGLY consistent flower in terms of the bloom, scape, rebloom, performance the summer after planting. One of my very best. Pretty, flawless blooms on every scape every day. Pictured on its sharkiest day; see website for a more typical day. (Note: it won't shark much if highs don't get out of the 60's and low 70's; otherwise not an issue). Holds great in heat and sun. Good opener. Fertile both ways with sharky kids. Good reports from its test in Cleveland where it was setting pods in high heat.....\$175

**UNSHAKABLE KINGDOM TET 26003** [Heartbeat of Heaven x (Born to Reign x Joan Derifield)], 24", LM, Dor, fr, Re (some MN instant Re), 7", 3 way (1 lateral plus V), 19 buds (range of 11-23), EMO (great early morning opener). Cranberry with lavender pink wash and lavender pink edge trimmer in ivory; yellow to green throat. Large, dramatic, gorgeous, ruffled, with wide segments. Makes huge fans. What's not to like? Slow to increase and almost impossible to set pods on. Pollen is fine, and has made some nice kids.....\$150

**VANISHING MIST TET 2604** [(Filled to Overflowing x Way of Life) x {(Light of the World x Way of Life) x [(Regal Majesty x Clothed in Glory) x Heartbeat of Heaven]}], 36", M, Sev, fr, Re, 5.5" (range of 5-6"), 5-way branching (with range of 3-5), 23 buds (range of 15-27). Cranberry grape with haunting large lavender eye; lavender edge trimmed in ivory; yellow to green throat. Sometimes the eye takes up most of the bloom. Gorgeous scapes, even on the outside of the clump and even when crowded (seems to grow outward rather than crowding inward). Fertile both ways and a wonderful parent for chalky eyes (see website).....\$100

## 2011 INTRODUCTION

**GNASHING OF TEETH TET 35502** {[Lifting Me Higher x Fortune's Dearest] x (Forbidden Desires x Tet. Lavender Blue Baby)] x [(Fortune's Dearest x Lifting Me Higher) x Doyle Pierce]}, 29" (24" in rough winters or until established in zone 4, and on rebloom), M (to late-mid), Ev, fr, reliable MN instant rebloom, 6-1/2" (up to 7"), 3-way branching (shape of a W) with 18 buds (2-way with 12 buds at Springwood in zone 4 in years 1 and 2 after planting, higher thereafter and with more snow cover), good opener. Grape cranberry with pale lavender eye and edge plus pale ivory to white teeth; yellow to green throat. AMAZING parent for large, very sharky, introduction quality kids in all color ranges and forms (see MY UTMOST FOR HIS HIGHEST and 2012 intro SOLI DEO GLORIA). Slower increaser (one fan will only go to two the next year, but faster when established). Sharky even when temps are in the high 60's to mid-70's, but will lose almost all of them in the 50's. Heavy dew will cause it to spot, but glorious when it doesn't and it doesn't pass that flaw on to most of the kids. Tested at Linda Agin's in Alabama and evaluated as outstanding as both a garden plant and a parent. Flawless in greenhouse settings. Super rust resistance. It emerges very, very late in the spring - it seems to know not to come out of the ground until after frost danger has passed - please don't worry and go digging around and looking for it. Also, the fans may look small and somewhat tentative as they first come up, but they will be quite large once the season gets going. Fertile both ways - easy pollen and average to above average pod fertility (hits 50-70% of the time in greenhouse).....\$250

**COLLECTION AND CLUB PRICING:** Order the entire 2012 collection of 12 plants (\$1,475 catalogue value) for \$1,175 plus \$22 shipping. Extra special pricing for club orders for auctions or "baby-sitting" plants.

**GUARANTEE:** Springwood Gardens' introductions are guaranteed for a year in zone 4 and higher if grown in normal garden conditions (e.g. grown in the ground rather than in pots, not in standing water, watered as needed, soil not overly compacted); that bark or other mulch is put around the plants to keep the roots cool and moist (no extra winter mulching needed); and that they're not divided when first received or during the first year. (Note: it's best to avoid dividing or transplanting daylilies when they are stressed by high temps or drought, and northerners report better success dividing daylilies in spring or early summer, rather than in the fall.)

**SALES INFORMATION:** Each order is important, and I personally choose each plant to be shipped. Plants are state-inspected. Shipping is by priority mail from March 15 to June 30 (although if I have time to ship after that I will). U.S shipments only. My goal is to send double fans or very large singles whenever I can, but how fast they increase is dependent on how much sun we get over the winter. In any event, I promise you will be happy with the size of your order as a whole. All Springwood introductions have been grown and tested outside before selection. They are not babied or given special care. They are planted on top of a cold, windswept hill with almost no snow cover. The ground around the daylilies is covered with a couple of inches of hardwood bark for weed control. They are given an inch of water a week during the growing season and no fertilizer. During bloom season, nights are typically in the 60's and days in the 80's and 90's, but in making evaluations, I watch carefully how the flowers open when temps are in the 50's. Introductions are lined out in the greenhouse in the summer (and grown in the ground in raised beds), enabling you to receive very large, high quality, blooming size plants when it's most convenient for you in the spring. I recognize that not everyone is enamored of plants grown in greenhouses, but in our climate it's the only way I'm able to ship before early June! Bloom occurs early in the greenhouse (like in Florida), and it is likely you will receive a plant that has already scaped. Most buyers report first year bloom (and often rebloom) on the majority of their plants, although not usually in sync with their peak bloom time. Northerners will find that their plants will re-establish more quickly if they request delivery after the soil has warmed up in their area and after hard frosts are expected.
